15days | 14 nights 12 – 26 April 2021

Sydney – Brisbane – Airlie Beach – Cairns – Darwin - Singapore

Day 1: Sydney. Embark on the beautiful Voyager of the Seas on our Crafty Adventure at Sea Scheepjes cruise with Dedri Uys and Tatsiana Kupryianchyk. Settle in to your cabin and explore the ship, and then meet your fellow Crafty Adventurers and hosts for a welcome event in the evening. Join us for dinner, and then enjoy the entertainment onboard, or relax in one of the many bars and lounges on the ship.

Day 2: At Sea. Today we will meet in the conference room onboard where we will start working on our first cruise projects. There will also be free time to enjoy the many activities offered on the ship. Enjoy dinner, and then maybe catch a show in the theatre.

Days 3: Brisbane. Today we will visit Brisbane – capital of the Sunshine State of Queensland. Relax and enjoy wandering this beautiful city, or maybe visit the nearby Gold Coast or Sunshine coast with their beautiful beaches, rainforests. Perhaps you could visit Australia Zoo – home to Steve Irwin's zoo and get up close and personal with some of our native wildlife.

Day 4: At Sea. Another relaxing day at sea to join your fellow crafters along with Dedri and Tatsiana in the conference centre to work on our projects.

Day 5: Airlie Beach. Enjoy a full day in the stunning Whitsunday Islands. Whether you'd like to sail, snorkel, dive, enjoy a scenic flight, or just relax, the Whitsundays have it all! World famous Whitehaven Beach has the most stunning white silica sand, and clearest blue water you're ever likely to see.

Day 6: Cairns. Today we will visit Cairns, home of the magnificent Great Barrier Reef. Head out on one of the many catamarans and explore the reef while searching for Nemo, Dory and their friends, or perhaps head up to Kuranda into the rainforest on the Kuranda Scenic Railway and Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. Kuranda is home to Aboriginal culture and you're sure to love the local craft markets which are open daily.

Days 7-9: At Sea. We have 3 full days at sea to really relax and work on our projects. You can also enjoy many of the other onboard activities and shows. The Voyager has plenty to keep the whole family occupied including flowrider, rock climbing, mini golf, water slides, their brand new laser tag, ice skating and much more as well as Dreamworks character parades, ice skating shows, and Broadway type shows in the theatre.

Day 10: Darwin. Our last port of call is in Australia's top end – the capital of the Northern Territory. You could visit the Royal Flying Doctors museum and WWII museum in town, or you will have the opportunity to visit Kakadu or Litchfield National Parks which are home to stunning scenery, waterfalls, rainforests, and Aboriginal rock art. Have a swim in one of the beautiful rock pools, or maybe see a crocodile (not at the same time)!

Days 11-14: At Sea. We have 4 more fabulous days at sea to work on our projects. We will include some social hooking time as well as structured workshops, and by now you will have made lifelong friends, so enjoy this special time with them. Perhaps try out some of the specialty restaurants onboard, and just relax. Join us for a farewell dinner, and some special awards on our last evening.

Day 15: Singapore This morning we sail into Singapore to conclude this once in a lifetime experience. After breakfast, farewell your fellow cruisers...until our next Crafty Adventure! Why not spend a few more days in Singapore and explore this beautiful city.
