Your itinerary

Crafty Adventure at Sea

12days | 11 nights 28 Sep – 9 Oct 2020

Southampton – Madeira - Tenerife - Las Palmas - Lisbon - Porto
- Vigo - Southampton

Day 1: Southampton UK. Embark on the beautiful Celebrity Silhouette on our Crafty Adventure at Sea cruise with Dedri Uys and Tammy Canavan. Settle in to your cabin and explore the ship, and then meet your fellow Crafty Adventurers and hosts for a welcome event in the evening. Join us for dinner, and then enjoy the entertainment onboard, or relax in one of the many bars and lounges on the ship.

Day 2-3: At Sea. We have 2 full days to start working on our projects. You will be allocated either a morning or afternoon class with Dedri and/or Tammy, and we will meet in the conference room onboard. If you are participating in both knitting and crochet workshops, you will have workshops in both the morning and afternoon. Enjoy dinner, and then maybe catch a show in the theatre.

Day 4: Madeira, Portugal. Our first port of call is the islands of Madeira. We will dock in Funchal, and you have the afternoon to explore. Perhaps visit the craft village of Camacha famous for wicker basket weaving, or enjoy a dolphin and whale watching cruise,

Day 5: Tenerife, Canary Islands. Tenerife is the largest of the Canary Islands and is dominated by the extinct Mt Tiede volcano. Enjoy the spectacular scenery in the world heritage listed Mt Tiede National Park, or relax on one of the many beaches.

Day 6: Las Palmas, Canary Islands. Today we will dock in the beautiful Las Palmas. One of the best things to do is sit back and relax in one of the many beautiful and bustling cobble stoned squares or plazas. There's plenty of history here also. Christopher Columbus spent time in Las Palmas in 1492 en-route to discovering America, and you can visit the Columbus House Museum during our stay - the very house where Columbus stayed while one of his ships was being repaired.

Day 7: At Sea. Back on board the ship for the whole day as we set sail for mainland Portugal once more, we will have our 3rd round of workshops with Dedri and Tammy. In your spare time, enjoy some relaxing crafting time with your new friends, or maybe shop up a storm in the Scheepjes shop onboard.

Day 8: Lisbon, Portugal. Today we visit the beautiful capital of Portugal. Lisbon is one of the most charismatic and vibrant cities in Europe - a postcard-perfect panorama of cobbled alleyways, ancient ruins, and white domed cathedrals. Visit the mid-11th century hilltop Sao Jorge Castle, or watch the world go by while relaxing in one of the many cafes.

Day 9: Porto, Portugal. Our last stop in Portugal is the beautiful Porto - famous for producing port wine. Located along the Douro River estuary in Northern Portugal, Porto is one of the oldest European centres, and it's historical core was listed as a Unesco World Heritage Site in 1996.

Day 10: Vigo, Spain. Our final port of call is the beautiful Vigo. Being a major fishing port, Vigo is a seafood lover's dream. The city also has several art galleries museums, and water sports. Visit the Castro Fortress which dates back to 1665, or enjoy one of the many beaches south west of the city centre.

Day 11: At Sea. We start our journey home, and on our final day at sea Dedri and Tammy will host their final workshops. By now you will have all the skills you need to complete your projects. We will get together on our final evening onboard for a farewell dinner and some awards.

Day 12: Southampton, UK This morning we sail into Southampton to conclude this once in a lifetime experience. After breakfast, farewell your fellow cruisers...until our next Crafty Adventure!
